Impact-ful

The word *impact* has two primary meanings: 1. to come into forcible contact with another object, and 2. to have a strong effect on someone or something. Too often our impact as Christians is more like the first. We collide into others, even those we want to help, damaging and disrupting as we go. We *hurt* when we really want to *help*. This isn't the type of impact that any of us want to have.

Impacting the world has little to do with forcible contact, and everything to do with affecting the lives of the vulnerable and needy in positive, life-changing ways. The truth is, ECM does impact lives! The 2018 Impact Report will help you to see how you are impacting those most desperate for the good news of Jesus, giving them hope for today, tomorrow, and eternity!

ECM is all about helping kids like:

- Didi, born in an isolated village in Congo, often sick, and heavily influenced by the evil powers of sorcery. ECM's staff led Didi's mother to Christ, rescuing her from the clutches of sorcery, and then brought the Gospel to a community mired in the curse of witchcraft;
- Marina, a child with albinism in Uganda, whose grandmother was so distraught over her light color that she used herbal remedies to try to change the skin color, only to cause permanent scarring; and
- Regina and Angela, Haven of Hope students in Ghana, who gained admission to nursing school, and now have a chance for a better future.

In this report you can read more examples of how you are impacting the lives of children in Africa. I invite you to have a closer look at the difference you are making by joining hands with ECM. You will see the amazing things that God does when his followers come together!

Making every dollar count has been an important goal for ECM since the ministry started in 1985. Yet our ultimate goal is simply to use all the resources God has given us as wisely as possible, for His glory.

Once again, during the past fiscal year ECM was able to keep its administrative spending to less than 10% of overall spending.

But it's not really about percentages. We believe that God is more interested in our faithful use of his resources than about what percentage of our income goes toward ministry and what percentage goes for administration. Ultimately, ALL of our resources, whether they go directly to Africa or stay right here in Indiana, are used to bring hope to children.

You can be confident that every dollar you give to this ministry is used properly and according to your wishes. We prayerfully consider how best to use all the funds we receive, and we make every effort to ensure that our staff uses integrity and transparency in all its financial and ministry decisions.

-Meeting Physical Needs-

- 34 children with albinism received medical help, education, and encouragement
- 12 grandmothers raising their grandchildren received new homes
- 6 children received critical surgeries or lifesaving medical treatments

HOPE FOR TOMORROW

-Educational Opportunities-

- 394 children were given the gift of education
- 65 children participated in university studies, vocational studies, and internships through the Next Step Program
- 5 US teachers provided mentoring for African teachers to help them improve professionally and grow spiritually

HOPE FOR ETERNITY

-Spiritual Growth-

- More than 300,000 children heard the gospel weekly through Sunday Schools started by ECM
- 394 children in sponsorship programs received spiritual teaching at Saturday Bible Clubs
- 350 children receivéd a Christ-centered education at Haven of Hope Academy
- 200+ children completed study of God's Word using Mail Box Club lessons

26 children received education, food, clothing and a big dose of Jesus' love at Haven of Hope Children's Home






110 school children in Sogakope heard the gospel and were discipled
